441 ebooks, 64 emagazines, and 271 downloadable audiobooks were checked out by Cloquet patrons in January. 8,084 items were checked out in January. The public computers were accessed through Cybrarian 1,816 times. Ancestry Library Edition was searched 1,392 times with 42 images and 379 text downloaded in January. Our web page had 3,270 sessions according to Google Analytics.
