LIBRARIAN'S REPORT

403 ebooks, 56 emagazines, and 257 downloadable audiobooks were checked out by Cloquet patrons in February. 8,081 items were checked out in February. The public computers were accessed through Cybrarian 1,635 times. Ancestry Library Edition was searched 515 times with 10 images and 163 text downloaded in February. Our web page had 2,945 sessions according to Google Analytics.
