LIBRARIAN'S REPORT

431 ebooks, 52 emagazines, and 412 downloadable audiobooks were checked out by Cloquet patrons in May. 8,074 items were checked out in May. The public computers were accessed through Cybrarian 2,113 times. Ancestry Library Edition was searched 1,308 times with 106 images and 356 text downloaded in May. Our web page had 3,271 sessions according to Google Analytics.

Our summer reading program is going well with good attendance at all of our programs. Over 300 children have signed up for the program.
