LIBRARIAN'S REPORT

465 ebooks, 17 emagazines, and 358 downloadable audiobooks were checked out by Cloquet patrons in July. 9,364 items were checked out in July. The public computers were accessed through Cybrarian 1,879 times. Ancestry Library Edition was searched 858 times with 409 images and 346 text downloaded in July. Our web page had 3,141 sessions according to Google Analytics.

The eclipse viewing party was very successful in spite of the clouds. We had about 70 people at the viewing party and handed out 850 viewing glasses.
