445 ebooks and 379 downloadable audiobooks were checked out by Cloquet patrons in August. Overdrive suddenly discontinued the emagazines, leaving us without a vendor for that service. 10,412 items were checked out in August. The public computers were accessed through Cybrarian 2,023 times. Ancestry Library Edition was searched 819 times with 201 images and 285 text downloaded in August. Our web page had 3,668 sessions according to Google Analytics.
