391 ebooks, 42 emagazines, and 348 downloadable audiobooks were checked out by Cloquet patrons in October. 8,665 items were checked out in October. The public computers were accessed through Cybrarian 2,225 times. Ancestry Library Edition was searched 261 times with 60 images and 36 text downloaded in October. My Heritage was searched 116 times. Newsbank was accessed 32 times. Our new web page had 3,189 sessions according to Google Analytics.
