LIBRARIAN'S REPORT

387 ebooks and 294 downloadable audiobooks were checked out by Cloquet patrons in May. The library checked out 8,614 items in May and public computers were accessed through Cybrarian 1,364 times. Ancestry Library Edition was searched 2,391 times with 606 images and 637 text downloaded in May. EBSCO My Heritage was searched 60 times with 745 page views and 13 records views. Newsbank was accessed 42 times. Our web page had 3,472 sessions according to Google Analytics.
