LIBRARIAN'S REPORT

410 ebooks and 294 downloadable audiobooks were checked out by Cloquet patrons in June. The library checked out 13,038 items in June and public computers were accessed through Cybrarian 1,595 times. Ancestry Library Edition was searched 2,271 times with 0 images and 856 text downloaded in June. EBSCO My Heritage did not have statistics available due to a technical error on their end. Newsbank was accessed 59 times. Our web page had 3,968 sessions according to Google Analytics. I am attaching customer comments that were posted to our Survey Monkey this year. Most of the comments request more open hours and identify space needs.
