450 ebooks and 255 downloadable audiobooks were checked out by Cloquet patrons in July. The library checked out 12,157 items in July and public computers were accessed through Cybrarian 2,034 times. Ancestry Library Edition was searched 1,819 times with 0 images and 578 text downloaded in July. EBSCO My Heritage was searched 58 times with 362 page views. Newsbank was accessed 17 times. Our web page had 3,924 sessions according to Google Analytics.
