Hi Ruth,

I've looked into having three large 4 x 10 ft. banners made by Advantage Emblem. The cost is \$140 per banner for a total of \$420. Their graphic designers would design the banners at no cost.

- One banner would go on the fence bordering 14th Street at Hilltop Park.
- One would go by the Cloquet sign located near Cloquet Ford Chrysler on Hwy 33.
- The third one would hopefully go in the vacant lot between Sammy's and The Warming House on Hwy 33. I will need to find out who owns the lot and get permission to place one there.
- If that location won't work then possibly on the fence at Athletic Park on 14th Street.

I will also be contacting Premiere Theatre again this year to set up advertising with them.


Last year we also did the WKLK Auction Show and gave away \$276 worth of Beach Passes, but I'm wondering if doing a couple of ads in the Cloquet Smart Shopper might be a wiser use of funds.

Another possibility is having Rack Cards printed again (I'm waiting to hear back on the cost for those – should be around \$400-\$500 for 10,000 cards). Last time we had 10,000 rack cards printed they lasted four years and were distributed in the Duluth/Cloquet and surrounding area at campgrounds, hotels, restaurants, etc.

Of course we will also do in house advertising: LumberLog, emails (Constant Contact and to past Beach pass holders using rSchool email), flyers sent home with students, and website.
