Finance

The GFOA awarded the GFOA Excellence in Financial Reporting to the CAFD for fiscal year-end 12/31/2015. Congratulations to Nancy who provides the fiscal services to the District and to the District for its commitment to work towards this designation and being recognized for this award.

Assessment Rate Policy

Following up from direction from the City Council, staff is working with the City Attorney to explore the question of retroactively looking at changes to the interest rate on older assessments from completed street improvement projects. The information will be presented to the Council after a legal opinion is obtained.

Community Sign

Staff was able to re-group this week with the National Guard after a long delay in discussions regarding a shared community sign to be conceptually placed at the National Guard Armory. Staff will continue to work on concepts associated to this project and present them at a later date to the City Council.

Miscellaneous

The crew has started erecting the various hockey rink boards in the Parks. With the fireworks planned for Veterans Park as part of the Home for the Holidays event a small glitch was run into related to safety zones. As a result, we will need to close Avenue B for a short period of time to ensure that vehicles and pedestrians are not in the safety zone. Efforts to minimize impact on truck traffic will be taken by closing the road for 15 minutes prior to and 15 minutes after the fireworks display.
