ADMINISTRATION

PERSONNEL

Interviews were conducted on Friday with the finalists for the Assistant City Administrator position. Staff continues to work on and complete end of the year performance evaluations. Staff was also busy working on a number of other human resource issues which were brought forward to the City Council.

CAFD BOARD

The CAFD met this week and authorized staff to work with the MN Legislature on amendments to its enabling resolution. The City Council had taken action in support of these amendments which would address certain financing aspects of the District.

CAHA

Staff met with CAHA this week to discuss the current financial condition of the organization, future capital improvements at the arena, and other related items. We are looking for the Board President to attend a Council Work Session meeting after the first of the year to provide an update for the full Council and as an opportunity to review the City's contractual agreements with the organization.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The School District received one proposal for the reuse of the Middle School. The developer is proposing an adaptive housing project. Next, staff has been asked to meet with District officials to discuss and review the proposal.

The Small Cities Grant Program continues moving forward in a positive way. staff issued 14 new owner-occupied awards, 6 rental awards, and 1 commercial award this week.

The City is also assisting the County by providing some background investigation to certain issues related to housing. Specifically, it involves the possible change in the Counties CAP and CHDO agencies. The County asked the City to help them understand the legal process required to make this change and are attempting to do so.

Staff and PD visited a property along Hwy 45 and served it with a violation notice for having used vehicles parked in the ROW, failing to maintain setbacks, customer parking and adequate internal navigation. PD accompanied staff as they received similar calls this week on the Hwy 45 property and other rental property owned by this individual in Cloquet storing numerous vehicles and a vehicle onsite at PD that has been there for two months.
