Tobacco 21 Ordinance

Meghann Levitt and Alli Mueller from Carlton County Public Health and Human Services gave an overview of the proposed Tobacco 21 Ordinance they are encouraging cities in Carlton County to pass. Ms. Levitt provided background on the local approach for the reduction of tobacco use for those under 21. Carlton County commissioners are considering passing the ordinance county wide. Community forums have been held to educate the public on the ordinance. Council will consider passing the ordinance at a future meeting.
