## ORDINANCE NO. 507A, AMENDING SECTION 5.6 OF CITY CODE – ATV PERMIT REQUIREMENTS – SECOND READING

**MOTION:** 

Councilor Keller moved and Councilor Wilkinson seconded the motion to approve ORDINANCE NO. 507A, AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION 5.6, REGULATING THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES, OFF-HIGHWAY MOTORCYCLES AND SPECIAL VEHICLES, INCLUDING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES, MOTORIZED GOLF CARTS, UTILITY TASK VEHICLES AND MINI-TRUCKS WITHIN THE CITY OF CLOQUET. The motion carried unanimously (7-0).

The City Council of the City of Cloquet does hereby ordain as follows:

**Section 1. City Code Amendment.** That the Cloquet City Code be amended by the addition of a new Subdivision 9 Permit, to Subsection 5.6.02 Definitions, of Section 5.6, Regulation of Snowmobiles, Off-Highway Motorcycles and Special Vehicles, Including All-Terrain Vehicles (ATV's), Motorized Golf Carts, Utility Task Vehicles and Mini-Trucks within City Limits, to read as follows:

#### 5.6.02 Definitions.

**Subd. 9 Permit.** "Permit" as used in this Section shall mean a permit issued by the City of Cloquet under the provisions of Subsection 5.6.04 below or an ATV registration card issued by the Commissioner of

Natural Resources pursuant to M.S.S. 84.922. Any motor vehicle regulated by this Section which bears a current permit/registration sticker for the vehicle being driven, affixed in a visible and readable location shall be considered to be properly permitted under this Section.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication in accordance with law.

## AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 9.2 PROJECT LABOR AGREEMENTS TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF "COVERED PROJECT" – SECOND READING

**MOTION:** 

Councilor Kolodge moved and Councilor Carlson seconded the motion to adopt ORDINANCE NO. 505A, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 9.2 PROJECT LABOR AGREEMENTS TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF "COVERED PROJECT". The motion passed (5-2), Councilors Lamb and Jaakola opposed.

The City Council of the City of Cloquet does hereby ordain as follows:

**Section 1. City Code Amendment.** That the Cloquet City Code be amended by replacing in its entirety the definition of "Covered Project" found in the paragraph titled "Covered Project Defined.", found in Section 9.2.02 of Section 9.2: Project Labor Agreements, of Chapter 9 - Public Works, to read as follows:

**Covered Project Defined.** "Covered Project" means that the City has a contract for construction services on a Project owned by the City with a total Project cost of \$175,000 or more.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication in accordance with law.

Year End Transfers for 2022

#### **Proposed Action**

Staff recommends the Council move to authorize the transfers for 2022 as detailed below.

#### **Background/Overview**

The council reviews and approves transfers before they are completed.

2022 Budgeted Transfers – The following transfers are budgeted annually.

- Transfer to the Library Fund from the General Fund of \$200,000.
- Transfer to General Fund from TIF 14<sup>th</sup> St Apartments of \$7,390.15
- Transfer to General Fund from TIF Trails Edge of \$528.28
- Transfer to General Fund from TIF Oakwood Estates of \$5,318.04
- Transfer to General Fund from TIF Patio Homes of \$4,513.02
- Transfer to General Fund from Landfill Host Fee Fund of \$36,210.65

<u>2022 Capital Improvements</u> – Expenditures were made in the Sales Tax Fund for the Antus Addition Water Utility Extension. This project was originally budgeted to be covered by sales tax, however, was approved to be paid by the landfill host fees at the May 10, 2022 Host Committee meeting.

• Transfer to the Sales Tax Fund from the Landfill Host Fee Fund of \$267,865.47.

Expenditures were made in the Revolving Capital Projects fund during the 22<sup>nd</sup> Street resurfacing project. The majority of the project was covered by state aid funds with a small amount coming from the water fund due to some utility improvements.

• Transfer to the Revolving Capital Projects Fund from the Water Fund of \$17,946.00

**Zoning Case 23-02: Minor Subdivision Plat - Elias** 

#### **Proposed Action**

The Planning Commission recommends the City Council move to adopt RESOLUTION NO. 23-17, A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MINOR SUBDIVISION PLAT OF ELIAS ADDITION FOR ANDREW ELIAS.

#### **Background/Overview**

Andrew Elias is proposing a minor subdivision plat for the creation of three lots on his 17-acre property. The property is located on the southwest corner of Laine and Stark Roads. The minor subdivision plat will not require the construction of any new roads. A wetland delineation has been done for the property and easements have been shown on the plat for the wetlands. Stark Road is a County Road and thus permits will be needed from Carlton County for access. The County has stated that a shared driveway will be needed for lots 1 and 2, lot 3 will access onto Laine Road which is a city street.

The property is Zoned FR – Farm Residential District and has a minimum lot width of 200 feet and a minimum lot area of 5-acres. The proposed lots meet or exceed these requirements.

A public hearing was be held on Tuesday, March 28, 2023 to consider the minor subdivision plat. A legal notice was published in the Pine Knot on March 17, 2023 and property owners within 350 feet were sent notices of the public hearing.

#### **Policy Objectives**

The Subdivision Code states Minor Subdivision plats may be granted when:

- 1. The subdivision is for residential development with a maximum of eight (8) lots.
- 2. The minimum lot dimensions and area shall be consistent with the requirements of the zoning district in which the lots are located.
- 3. The proposed lots shall have frontage on an existing public road for the minimum lot width requirements in the Cloquet Zoning Ordinance.
- 4. There shall be no new road or utility extensions involved in a Minor Subdivision.
- 5. The subdivision complies with all other requirements of the Cloquet Zoning Ordinance.

#### **Financial Impacts**

The Minor Subdivision fee is \$300. The applicant has paid this fee to cover the cost associated with the application process.

#### **Advisory Committee/Commission Action**

There was a neighbor to the east of the development who had concerns of increased traffic with additional homes being build and the potential of more homes on other property owned by Mr. Elias. Staff noted the Zoning for the area allowed for 5-acre lots and that these were all in excess of that. Following minimal discussions and reviewing the Minor Subdivision requirements, the Planning Commission recommended approval of the Minor Subdivision on a 3-0 vote.


- 1. There shall be a shared driveway for Lots 1 and 2 with no other driveway access points onto Stark Road/Co. Rd. 116.

## **LOCATION MAP**



Elias Addition - Engineering review

I have reviewed Plat for the "Elias Addition". The following are my comments on the plans submitted.

- 1. The plat divides the parcel into 3 buildable lots. No grading is shown but based on roughly 10,000 SF of disturbed area to create a building pad and driveway per lot this would be a total of 30,000 SF of disturbed area. This is under the threshold that would require a grading plan and SWPPP (43,560 SF), therefore it is not required for the developer to prepare these plans for review and approval.
- 2. Lot 3 fronts on Laine Road which is a city road and driveway access will need to be coordinated with Public works. At the time the driveway is to be install the owner should contact public works to identify the driveway location at which time City staff will make a determination on the size and location of a driveway culvert. The City will provide this culvert but the cost is the responsibility of the property owner.
- 3. The other two lots (lots 1 and 2) front on Stark Road. Access to Stark road is regulated by Carlton County. The owner shall apply for driveway access with Carlton County and meet any requirements of that permit.
