NORTHWOODS ARENA ICE PLANT REPAIR

MOTION: Councilor Kolodge moved and Councilor Carlson seconded the motion to authorize the

proposal from Commercial Refrigeration for Northwoods Arena ice system repairs in the

amount of \$51,441.00. The motion carried unanimously (5-0).

APPROVE POLICE OFFICER APPOINTMENT

probationary appointment of Jacob Bubb to the position of Police Officer. The motion

carried unanimously (5-0).

GFOA CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT

The City has received the GFOA Certificate of Achievement for 2020-2021. Finance Director Katie Bloom explained the lengthy process it takes to achieve this award. Administrator Peterson stated this award is not easily achieved and is a continuation of excellence by former Finance Director Nancy Klassen.

COUNCIL COMMENTS, ANNOUNCEMENTS, AND UPDATES

Administrator Peterson gave information on two capital projects that may be of interest to submit for capital bonding in 2024. He explained the lengthy process of submitting the applications and the potential of not receiving the funding.

The two projects worth trying to get funding are a new public works facility and a redesign or repurpose of the St. Louis pedestrian bridge. Peterson provided cost breakouts and options for both projects. The public works facility is a \$15 million project that would be done in phases. Requested funding would be \$7.5 million. The pedestrian bridge is a \$2 million project and the requested amount would be \$1 million. There are also several grant opportunities for the bridge that will be sought after.

Mr. Peterson would like consensus from the Council to submit for bonding for one or both projects, if any. Councilors agreed the city should try to get funding for both projects.

Public Works Director Caleb Peterson stated that brush pick-up is close to being complete. If residents have brush that was placed for pick up but was not, call City Hall and it will be picked up by June 30th.

Councilor Wilkinson reminded that the next City Council meeting is July 18th.

ADJOURNMENT

On a motion duly carried by a unanimous yea vote of all members present on roll call, the Council adjourned.

Memorandum of Agreement for Building Inspection Services 2023

Proposed Action

Staff recommends the Council move to approve the Memorandum of Agreement (MOU) for building inspection services between the City of Cloquet and Fond du Lac Reservation ("Band").

Background/Overview

Since 2010, the City has provided building inspection services non-routinely for the Band which ended. The Band continues to have special projects for which they request building code inspection services, typically for larger projects from the City's Building Official to ensure correct construction. With ongoing billing, the City's Finance Director has requested an updated MOU. Staff has reached out to FDL to discuss and they have executed the attached MOU.

Attached, the Council will find an MOU which the City has used and periodically updated as needed for building inspections srevices for the Fond Du Lac Reservation (hereafter referred to as the "Band" or "FDL"). The Band is interested in ensuring quality control of buildings and that hired contractors are building to industry standards. As directed by the Band, the City will inspect and implement the building code standards even though FDL is not required to enforce this standard (International Building Code or State of Minnesota Building Code). All commercial level plan review, permitting, and legal enforcement will be handled by FDL staff.

Policy Objectives

The City needs to have a validly executed Memorandum of Agreement in place between the City and Band to provide building inspection services.

Financial Impacts/Budget/Grant Considerations

Providing this service to the Band has been a revenue source for the City in the past. The hourly rate for inspection services will be \$80/hour (which includes mileage). This rate has been examined and is the same rate as 2017 and is a rate that continues to cover costs.

Memorandum of Agreement for Building Inspection Services 2023

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR BUILDING INSPECTION SERVICES

This Memorandum of Agreement, entered into this 2/ day of _______, 2023 by and between the Fond du Lac Band of Lake Superior Chippewa, 1720 Big Lake Road, Cloquet, Minnesota 55720 ("Band"), and the City of Cloquet, Minnesota, 101 14th Street, Cloquet, Minnesota 55720 ("City"), concerning the performance by the City of building inspection services on behalf of the Band, shall be governed by the terms and conditions contained herein.

WHEREAS, the Band is a sovereign Indian tribal nation that occupies the Fond du Lac Reservation pursuant to the Treaty of LaPointe of September 30, 1854, and retains inherent civil regulatory authority over its own affairs on the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the City's Community Development Department maintains a certified Building Official to conduct building inspections which operates in accordance with state and municipal laws; and

WHEREAS, the Band has requested the development of a fee-for service arrangement with the City whereby the City would perform inspection services for the Band and bill the Band fore such services ("Agreement");

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Performance of Inspection Services. Upon request from the Band, and subject to the City Building Official's availability, the City's Building Official shall perform building code inspections on construction projects which are being undertaken by the Band. Such inspections shall be performed in accordance with the substantive standards established under Minnesota law, and shall be documented by the City Building Official in the same manner as other similar inspections ("Inspection Reports"). Electronic or hard copies of building plans, plan check/plan review analysis, and all project correspondence will be forwarded to the City Building Official to ensure knowledge for proper field inspections.
- 2. <u>Workers Compensation</u>. The City Building Official is an employee of the City and the City will maintain workers compensation insurance covering the City Building Official at all times while the City Building Official is providing services pursuant to this Agreement.
- 3. <u>Compliance with Inspection Reports</u>. Upon the receipt of the Inspection Reports, the Band shall assume full responsibility for any and all compliance and enforcement required under such Reports.

- 4. <u>Indemnification</u>. The Band shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend the City, its Building Official, officers, employees and agents against any and all liability, loss, costs, damages, expenses, claims, or actions the City hereafter may sustain, incur or be required to pay, arising out of or by reason of any act or omission in the execution of performance of the City's obligation pursuant to this Agreement consistent with the liability provisions of Minn. Stat. 471.59.
- 5. <u>Confidentiality</u>. All parties providing services hereafter agree to abide by the provisions of the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act.
- 6. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Agreement shall be held by any court of contempt jurisdiction to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable, such provision shall be construed as enforced as if it had been more narrowly drawn so as to be legal, valid or enforceable. Such illegality, invalidity or unenforceability shall not have effect upon or impact the enforceability of any other provision of this Agreement.
- 7. <u>Billing</u>. Upon the completion of inspection services, in a billing cycle advised by the City Finance Director, the City shall invoice the Band for the cost of services rendered, at the rate of \$80.00 per hour, due and payable net 30 days from receipt of invoice.
- 8. <u>Term.</u> This MOA shall commence on this <u>2</u>/ day of <u>june</u>, 2023, and will be ongoing as requested, financially reviewed annually at the beginning of each year, and shall terminate upon 30 days written notice by either party.
- 9. <u>Retention of Immunity</u>. Nothing in this MOA shall be construed as waiving any governmental immunity vested in either under existing law.

Requested Action

The Council is asked to approve RESOLUTION NO. 23-35, A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SALE OF A VACANT SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL LOT AT 333 20th STREET FROM THE CITY OF CLOQUET TO BOSS BUILDERS LLC FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF HOUSING.

Background/Overview

At the June 20, 2023 City Council meeting, Council authorized the repurchase of 333 20th Street via Resolution 23-32. Sherman Inc. purchased a tax forfeit lot for housing redevelopment, a project that withdrew after examining construction cost options.

The Cloquet EDA issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) on June 12th to local contractors which was due back to the City by June 30th. The lot is roughly 80' x 110' and zoned R-2. Three local contractors examined the property;

however Boss Builders LLC was the only respondent to the formal RFP request and submitted three different redevelopment options, attached to this staff report, those were:

- 1. Twin-home (for-sale units)
- 2. Single family (for-sale three bedroom)
- 3. Single Family (for-sale two bedroom)

All proposed homes are slab-on-grade ADA compliant format and attractive to all age demographics. The contractor reports that construction would begin in spring of 2024 but depending on weather and schedules, dirt work could potentially occur this fall.

Policy Objectives

The mission of the Cloquet Economic Development Authority (EDA) is to take an active role in attracting new businesses to the community, retaining existing businesses, assisting businesses with expansion, and enabling rehabilitation and/or redevelopment of areas within the community. The goal of work activities by the EDA is to grow the local economy through focused efforts that stimulate economic investment and grow prosperity in the Cloquet region. The 2023 Cloquet EDA Work Plan has the number one goal of:

Tandem Dump Truck with Box and Plow Equipment Purchase

Proposed Action

Staff recommends the City Council move to authorize the order of an International tandem dump truck from Mid-State Truck Service of Duluth in the amount of \$129,535.79 including trade, and the purchase of a dump box and plow package from Townmaster Equipment in the amount of \$183,810.00.

Background/Overview/Feasibility

As part of the 2025 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) and annual budget, a new tandem axle dump truck is scheduled to be purchased by the Public Works Department. In order for the city to expect receipt of the truck in 2025 we must order the truck and plow package now. Due to supply shortages and elongated build times, it is common for this to happen one to two years in advance of the scheduled purchase.

Due to the age of this truck and its counterpart (#213), we have seen frequent failures over the past two years. Failures of emissions equipment have resulted in downtime during plowing season and overruns on the equipment maintenance budget.

The truck to be traded in will be our tandem axle dump truck, Vin#1HTWPAZT4DJ255942 (City Unit #212). At the time of trade, Unit #212 will be 12 years old. Mid-State of Duluth was the only vendor that submitted a qualifying quote with price guarantees and a trade-in number, therefore staff recommends purchase of the tandem axle dump truck from Mid-State. The box and plow equipment will be purchased from Towmaster Equipment. The following is a summary of the bids received:
